
Step 2

For which game is the setup? In my example we are posting a BMW E90 setup for Race07. Click on Race 07.

Go to the <GameName> Setups subforum; in my example the Race 07 Setups subforum.



Step 4

Choose the desired car type (this can vary from game to game); for Race 07 we have Touring Cars (Seat/Alfa/BMW/Honda/etc) and Open Wheel (Caterhams/Radicals/F3000/FBMW).

For my example we choose Touring Car.

Step 5

Choose for which car the setup is; in this case BMW E90 320si




Step 6

If there is already a thread for the *Car – Track* head to the already existing thread.

If there is no thread for your *Car – Track* goto Appendix A.

Example: If you want to post a BMW E90 setup for Monza click on the shown thread.



Step 7


Once inside the thread, click **Post Reply** to post a new message in which you can attach your setup.



Step 8


Type a message you like and/or give information about your laptime or what you changed; etc.etc.

Select the Disk icon below to indicate you have something to download. This helps others which threads/postings contains downloadable files.



Step 9

Scroll down the screen and click on **Manage Attachments** to open the Add attachments window.



Step 10

Click browse to search and select your setup file. For Race07 the setups are stored in `..\Steam\SteamApps\<YourSteamName>\race 07\UserData\CarSetups\<TrackName>\`

Select your `<setupname>.svm` file and click open to select it.

Next click on **Upload** to attach the setup to the Posting.

Appendix A

If there is currently not an existing thread about your *Car – Track*, just make a thread yourself.

Click **New Thread** to create a new thread.




Next type your title; please do it carefully and learn from what others type. In our example *BMW E90 320si – TrackName*. Replace *TrackName* for your trackname;


Type a message to others, maybe some laptimes/adjustments you did. Etc.etc.

In the Tags field, type *CarSetup*. This way others can search with tags to carsetups which make life for all of us much easier.

Select the Disk icon to indicate the newly created thread contains at least one downloadable file.



Scroll down and click **Manage Attachments** to add the attachment.


